## AN ACT

- Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An act relating to the public school system, including certain
- 3 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial
- schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the
- laws relating thereto," providing for youth suicide awareness
- and prevention training.
- 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 8 hereby enacts as follows:
- 9 Section 1. The act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), known
- 10 as the Public School Code of 1949, is amended by adding a
- 11 section to read:
- 12 Section 1205.7. Youth Suicide Awareness and Prevention
- 13 Training. -- (a) Beginning with the 2014-2015 school year, the
- 14 professional development plan submitted by each school entity to
- 15 the secretary for approval pursuant to section 1205.1 shall
- 16 include four (4) hours of training in youth suicide awareness
- 17 and prevention every five (5) years for professional educators

- 1 <u>in school buildings serving students in grade six (6), seven</u>
- 2 (7), eight (8), nine (9), ten (10), eleven (11) or twelve (12).
- 3 Training under this subsection may be used to satisfy a
- 4 professional educator's continuing professional education
- 5 requirement under section 1205.2.
- 6 (b) Within one hundred eighty (180) days of the effective
- 7 date of this section, the Department of Education, in
- 8 <u>consultation with the Department of Health, shall develop and</u>
- 9 <u>make available on its publicly accessible Internet website</u>
- 10 recommended guidelines and educational materials for the
- 11 training required under subsection (a), which may include
- 12 materials which are already publicly available. In providing the
- 13 training required under subsection (a), a school entity shall
- 14 not be required to use the guidelines and materials developed
- 15 <u>and made available by the Department of Education.</u>
- (c) For purposes of this section, "school entity" shall mean
- 17 a school district, joint school district, charter school,
- 18 regional charter school, cyber charter school, intermediate unit
- 19 or area vocational-technical school.
- 20 Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2013, or
- 21 immediately, whichever is later.
