BILL SUMMARY House Bill 1164, Printer's No. 1605 Prime Sponsor: Representative Murt

SYNOPSIS:

House Bill 1164 establishes the Higher Education Course Scheduling Preference for Veteran Students Act.

BILL ANALYSIS:

Within 90 days of the effective date, the Department of Education in consultation with public institutions of higher education, including community colleges, state-related institutions, and state system of higher education (PASSHE) institutions, shall develop guidelines for these institutions to provide preference in course scheduling for veteran students.

Public institutions will have up to 180 days from the effective date to comply with the guidelines developed by the department or implement their own policy for providing veteran students with preference in course scheduling.

Effective Date: Immediately.
