AN ACT

Providing for matriculating veteran students to receive a course <-scheduling preference at public institutions of higher 2 education. 3 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 5 hereby enacts as follows: Section 1. Short title. 6 This act shall be known and may be cited as the Higher Education Course Scheduling Preference for Matriculating Student <--Veterans VETERAN STUDENTS Act. <--Section 2. Definitions. 10 11 The following words and phrases when used in this act shall 12 have the meanings given to them in this section unless the 13 context clearly indicates otherwise: "Matriculating veteran student." An individual who: 14 <--15 (1) is a veteran; 16 (2) has received an honorable discharge from any branch

- 1 of the uniformed services;
- 2 (3) has been admitted to a public institution of higher
- 3 education; and
- 4 (4) resides in this Commonwealth while enrolled at the
- 5 public institution of higher education.
- 6 "Public institution of higher education." A community <--
- 7 college, a State related institution or a member institution of
- 8 the State System of Higher Education. ONE OF THE FOLLOWING:
- 9 (1) A COMMUNITY COLLEGE UNDER ARTICLE XIX-A OF THE ACT
- OF MARCH 10, 1949 (P.L.30, NO.14), KNOWN AS THE PUBLIC SCHOOL
- 11 CODE OF 1949.
- 12 (2) A STATE-RELATED INSTITUTION, TO INCLUDE THE
- PENNSYLVANIA STATE UNIVERSITY, THE UNIVERSITY OF PITTSBURGH,
- 14 TEMPLE UNIVERSITY AND LINCOLN UNIVERSITY AND THEIR BRANCH
- 15 CAMPUSES.
- 16 (3) A MEMBER INSTITUTION OF THE STATE SYSTEM OF HIGHER
- 17 EDUCATION UNDER ARTICLE XX-A OF THE PUBLIC SCHOOL CODE OF
- 18 1949.
- 19 "VETERAN." AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:
- 20 (1) HAS SERVED IN THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES,
- 21 INCLUDING A RESERVE COMPONENT AND NATIONAL GUARD; AND
- 22 (2) WAS DISCHARGED OR RELEASED FROM SUCH SERVICE UNDER
- 23 CONDITIONS OTHER THAN DISHONORABLE.
- "VETERAN STUDENT." AN INDIVIDUAL WHO:
- 25 (1) IS A VETERAN;
- 26 (2) HAS BEEN ADMITTED TO A PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER
- 27 EDUCATION; AND
- 28 (3) RESIDES IN THIS COMMONWEALTH WHILE ENROLLED IN THE
- 29 PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION.
- 30 Section 3. Course scheduling preference.

- 1 (a) General rule.--Within 90 180 days of the effective date <--
- 2 of this section, a public institution of higher education shall
- 3 provide matriculating student veterans with the same VETERAN <--
- 4 STUDENTS WITH preference in course scheduling as the preferences <--
- 5 provided for upper classmen and other students that receive-
- 6 priority scheduling at the public institution of higher-
- 7 education. PURSUANT TO GUIDELINES DEVELOPED BY THE DEPARTMENT OF <--
- 8 EDUCATION UNDER SUBSECTION (B).
- 9 (B) GUIDELINES.--WITHIN 90 DAYS OF THE EFFECTIVE DATE OF
- 10 THIS SECTION, THE DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION, IN CONSULTATION WITH
- 11 PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION, SHALL DEVELOP
- 12 GUIDELINES UNDER WHICH PUBLIC INSTITUTIONS OF HIGHER EDUCATION
- 13 SHALL PROVIDE PREFERENCE IN COURSE SCHEDULING TO VETERAN
- 14 STUDENTS.
- 15 (b) (C) Existing policies.--If, on WITHIN 180 DAYS OF the <--
- 16 effective date of this section, a public institution of higher
- 17 education has established and implemented a policy relating to <--
- 18 preference in course scheduling that includes veterans and the
- 19 policy complies with this act, the public institution of higher-
- 20 education shall not be required to establish and implement a new-

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- 21 policy under the provision of this act. UNDER WHICH VETERAN
- 22 STUDENTS ARE PROVIDED WITH PREFERENCE IN COURSE SCHEDULING, THE
- 23 PUBLIC INSTITUTION OF HIGHER EDUCATION SHALL BE CONSIDERED TO BE
- 24 IN COMPLIANCE WITH SUBSECTION (A).
- 25 Section 4. Effective date.
- This act shall take effect immediately.
