Amending the act of March 10, 1949 (P.L.30, No.14), entitled "An 1 act relating to the public school system, including certain 2 provisions applicable as well to private and parochial 3 schools; amending, revising, consolidating and changing the laws relating thereto," further providing for school police 5 officers. 6 7 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania 8 hereby enacts as follows: 9 Section 1. Section 778(f) of the act of March 10, 1949 10 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, amended June 25, 1997 (P.L.297, No.30), is amended and the 11 12 section is amended by adding a subsection to read: 13 Section 778. School Police Officers. --* * * School districts and municipalities may enter into 14 15 cooperative police service agreements pursuant to 42 Pa.C.S. § 16 8953(e) (relating to Statewide municipal police jurisdiction) and 53 Pa.C.S. § 2303 (relating to intergovernmental cooperation 17 18 authorized) to authorize the exercise of concurrent jurisdiction

with local law enforcement within the municipality where the
