AN ACT

- 1 Amending Title 51 (Military Affairs) of the Pennsylvania 2 Consolidated Statutes, further providing for educational
- 3 leave of absence.
- 4 The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania
- 5 hereby enacts as follows:
- 6 Section 1. Section 7313 of Title 51 of the Pennsylvania
- 7 Consolidated Statutes is amended to read:
- 8 § 7313. Educational leave of absence.
- 9 Whenever any member of the Pennsylvania National Guard or
- 10 other reserve component of the armed forces of the United States
- 11 shall be called or ordered to active duty, other than active
- 12 duty for training, including, in the case of members of the
- 13 Pennsylvania National Guard, active State duty, the educational
- 14 institution in which the member is enrolled shall grant the
- 15 member or the member's spouse a military leave of absence from
- 16 their education. The member or the member's spouse shall receive

- 1 an "M" on their grade transcript for all classes they are unable
- 2 to complete due to a military leave of absence. Members and
- 3 spouses on military leave of absence from their educational
- 4 institution shall be entitled, upon the member's release from
- 5 military duty, to be restored to the educational status they had
- 6 attained prior to the member's being ordered to military duty
- 7 without loss of academic credits earned, scholarships or grants
- 8 awarded or tuition and other fees paid prior to the commencement
- 9 of the military duty. It shall be the duty of the educational
- 10 institution to refund tuition or fees paid or to credit the
- 11 tuition and fees to the next semester or term after the
- 12 termination of the educational military leave of absence at the
- 13 option of the student.
- 14 Section 2. This act shall take effect in 60 days.
