SYNOPSIS:

Senate Bill 1450 amends the Public School Code to provide for school entity flexibility on the Keystone Exams.

BILL ANALYSIS:

Senate Bill 1450 amends the Public School Code to provide that beginning in the 2016-2017 school year, a school entity will be able to determine the use of Keystone Exam scores locally. School entities may, but are not limited to, use the exam scores as end of course grades, indicators for remediation or as a graduation requirement.

Effective Date: 60 days.
