BILL SUMMARY

House Bill 2049, Printer's No. 3050

Prime Sponsor: Representative Simmons

SYNOPSIS:

House Bill 2049 amends the Public School Code to provide for epinephrine auto-injector administration by school bus drivers.

BILL ANALYSIS:

House Bill 2049 amends the Public School Code to provide for epinephrine auto-injector administration by school bus drivers. School bus drivers may administer epinephrine auto-injectors if they have received Department of Health training and follow the policies set by the school entity and the independent contractor, if applicable.

The legislation further requires the Department of Health to create a training program in 90 days and grants civil immunity to the school bus drivers when following the policies.

Effective Date: 60 days.
