SENATE BILL 1194-SENATOR MENSCH

SYNOPSIS:

Repeals the expiration date for the State Military College Legislative Appointment Initiative Program.

SUMMARY:

Repeals the expiration date for the State Military College Legislative Appointment Initiative Program. The program was enacted in 2012 and set to expire June 30, 2016.

Effective Date: 60 days.

BILL HISTORY:

Act 29 of 2012 permitted each member of the General Assembly to make an annual appointment of a qualified constituent to the freshman class at Valley Forge Military Academy and College. The students are also eligible to receive a full scholarship funded by Valley Forge. The process is similar to congressional appointments to military academies, but on a state level.
