22 Allocation

23 Section 1101. Allocation of funds.

24 (a) Allocation.--

25 (1) Eighty percent of money appropriated shall be used

1 to provide grants to the entities described in paragraphs
2 (1), (2), (3), (4), (5), (6), (7) and (8) of the definition
3 of "adult education provider" in section 102.

4 (2) Twenty percent of money appropriated shall be used
5 to provide grants to entities described in paragraph (9) of
6 the definition of "adult education provider" in section 102
7 for programs that serve adult learners who hold a secondary
8 diploma or its recognized equivalent and need additional
9 training to reenter the workforce.

10 (b) Reallocation.--The department may reallocate between the
11 grants specified in subsection (a) any unspent money resulting
12 from insufficient applicants following the initial grant
13 application period.
