<u>Topics of Discussion – Title 24 and Truancy in Our Schools</u>

There are basically four core topics that we would like to concentrate on...

- 1. The need to prioritize truancy from the very beginning of "compulsory school age"
 - Increase focus on elementary students, and establish early guidelines
 - Attendance Improvement Plans (AIP) and mandated parental participation
 - Early action we cannot allow for 30, 40, 50 absences before action
- 2. School identification of underlying, contributing factors leading to truancy
 - Student/Parent mental health
 - Socio-economic circumstances of family
 - Obstacles to learning within the school, such as bullying and confrontation
- 3. Ease of Student mobility
 - District to district movement to avoid truancy actions/prosecution
 - Brick and mortar exit to cyber school to avoid truancy
- 4. Non-monetary penalties and deterrence
 - School based penalties required academic community service for students and school-based community service for parents. Payment plans are not a deterrent.
 - Allow for more serious graded offenses for repeat offenders. An offense graded as a misdemeanor 3 offense could allow for Court of Common Pleas, Probation Services and Children/Youth Services involvement.
