1 Amend Bill, page 2, lines 3 through 11, by striking out "A
2 school district and municipality may enter into a" in line 3 and
3 all of lines 4 through 11 and inserting

4 (1) If a school is located within a municipality where no
5 municipal police department exists, the school district may
6 enter into a cooperative police service agreement pursuant to 42
7 Pa.C.S. § 8953(e) and 53 Pa.C.S. § 2303 with a municipality
8 providing full-time police coverage that is located adjacent to
9 the school. At least thirty (30) days prior to executing a
10 cooperative police service agreement under this subsection, the
11 school district shall provide written notice of its intent to
12 enter into the agreement to the municipality where the school is
13 located. A copy of the executed agreement shall be provided to
14 the commanding officer of the Pennsylvania State Police
15 installation that provides primary police services to the
16 municipality where the school is located.

17 (2) A cooperative police service agreement entered into
18 under this subsection shall only pertain to actions taken on
19 school property pursuant to the agreement and shall not affect
20 the jurisdiction of the Pennsylvania State Police.
