Section 1725-A of the act of March 10, 1949 12 (P.L.30, No.14), known as the Public School Code of 1949, is 13 amended by adding a subsection to read: 14 Section 1725-A. Funding for Charter Schools.--* * * 15 (f) As the Commonwealth suspends or eliminates its 16 contributions or payments to charter schools, regional charter 17 schools or cyber charter schools under 24 Pa.C.S. §§ 8326 18 (relating to contributions by the Commonwealth) or 8535 19 (relating to payments to school entities by Commonwealth), in 20 connection with the act of April 9, 1929 (P.L.343, No.176), 21 22 known as The Fiscal Code, the Department of Education shall allocate up to \$30,000,000 to school districts through a block 23 grant program to be created for the 2014-2015 fiscal year which 24 25 school districts may use for the purpose of offsetting cyber charter school expenses. 26

Section 2. This act shall take effect July 1, 2014, or
